▶ DIFFERENCE BETWEEN BREAD OF LIFE AND PHYSICAL BREAD

*the physical bread only give the body energy, and sustain the body for a period of time. While, the bread of life sustained the body for ever till eternity

✦ Content: when Jesus was saying I'm the bread the of life, what does he means:

▶ it means we cannot be satisfied spiritually if we don't have him(Jesus).

▶ we can survive if we don't know him (Jesus).

*□ when Jesus was in fasting (forty days and forty night) when he wanted to break, devil came to him and told him that if he his the true son of God that he should take a stone and turn it to bread, but Jesus told him man shall not live by bread alone (the physical one) but by the word of God

•□ he said that because he knew the bread profited not, because devil was tempting him then

✦ Evaluation: Pupils to:

- ▶ Explain who said man must live by bread alone
- ▶ who tempted Jesus?

Week: 10th week

Class: primary 3

Topic: (Jesus) the word of God

✦ Behavioural objectives: Pupils should be able to:

- ▶ use the word of God when in temptation.

✦ Instructional material/Reference material: textbook and charts.

✦ Building Background /connection to prior knowledge: Pupils has been taught on Jesus the bread of life

✦ Content: when Jesus was in the wilderness fasting, Satan came to meet him to tempt him (he tempted him three times).

- the second time he tempted Jesus, he told him to jump from the pinnacle of the temple that the angels of the lord will guide him for his foot not to be strike with stones, and Jesus replied him not to tempt the lord his God

☛ the third time he came to tempt him he reply him with (you shall worship the lord your God and him only we shall serve.

▶ so wherever we meet ourselves and devil is tempting us defeat him with the word of God

✦ Evaluation: Pupils to:

▶ explain the second temptation and the last word Jesus told Satan
